The **European Mediation Network Initiative (EMNI)** gathers mediators from over 20 countries and aims at:

- a) promoting an international exchange of information, know-how and mutual support amongst mediators;
- b) promoting the development of effective mediation policies, services and legislation;
- c) exploring and developing the theoretical basis of mediation and promotion of research;
- d) promoting the development of principles, ethics, standards and good practice.

In this perspective, and to provide an opportunity for sharing information, know-how and above all for the development of mediation, **EMNI organizes in Bourg La Reine – Grand Paris (Hauts-de-Seine), on May 27 & 28, 2010, the third European Conference on Mediation:**

"Mediation and Civil Society in Europe, towards a New Mindset"

This event will gather approximately 400 participants: mediators, researchers in mediation and conflict management, lawyers, managers, consultants, company owners, elected representatives from European countries and people in charge of local and regional non-profit organizations.
